

# Dublin Youth Athletics (DYA) Travel Basketball



## Frequently Asked Questions Answered

### **1. How do I register for DYA Travel Basketball tryouts?**

Everyone who wants to try out for Travel Basketball MUST register for the Recreational Basketball program first, including payment. There is a question on the Recreational Basketball registration form that asks, "Are you trying out for DYA Travel Basketball?" Answer "Yes" and complete the registration and you'll be registered for Travel Basketball tryouts. This process prevents the child from being wait-listed for the Recreational League in the event they do not make a Travel team.

### **2. What is the program fee for DYA Travel Basketball?**

The fee for participation in Travel Basketball for 2025-2026 is \$350. Everyone must pay the Recreational League fee for the respective age group prior to trying out. Players making the team will be billed online for the remaining balance prior to the start of the season.

### **3. Is there a uniform fee?**

Yes, there is a uniforms fee (TBD). Parents will need to purchase the uniform. There will be a uniform fitting for each team. Fitting Dates will be announced after teams are selected.

### **4. How many days of tryouts do we need to attend?**

There will be two tryout sessions for Boys and Girls per Grade. It is preferred that players attend both sessions to receive maximum exposure to the evaluators.

### **5. When are tryouts held?**

Tryouts are usually held in mid/late September on weeknight evenings at a Dublin middle school. Parents should check their child in at the gym prior to the tryout start time. A mandatory parents meeting occurs following check-in on the first night of tryouts and lasts about 15-30 minutes, depending on questions.

### **6. Who coaches DYA Travel Basketball teams?**

Coaches are parents or volunteers from the community who have successfully completed a background check and completed all local/state/federal requirements.
